QUANTUM PHYSICS, TELEPATHY AND SUNDAY CONTACTS, SUNDAY AUGUST 8TH, 65

Why do we meet at 11 AM on Sunday?... to send love to Elohim?

Is it an important meeting for you ? You come from far, you all travel on the road under a hot weather. Gasoline is expensive, highway fees are expensive in Japan too, why are you here?

.... yes, to be together for Elohim, saying 'present', we are here for you, we are here for humanity. That's why it's so important. We can do it alone in our house, but it's not the same. Being together make it more powerful for everything.

It is the same for meditation, we can do it alone but together it is more powerful. Soon scientists will be able to explain why, it's part of the messages.

One brain alone is powerful, but many brains together are more powerful.

When you do meditation alone at home you feel good. When we do it together, it feels better. Did you notice, Why is that so?

That's something scientists will explain in the future. They start a little bit to understand. It's connected to what they call quantum physics.

What is quantum physics? It's a physics that is completely irrational for normal scientists until recently and still now many scientists cannot understand it. To give a simple image, let's imagine a small particle, a photon for example, -photons are particles of light-, moving in one direction. If you modify the trajectory of this particle, another particle, behind a wall, will be modified as when. When you move the 1st one, the other one will move also.

That is quantum physics. It's very important.

And it is, something I say for the first time: this is of course connected with Telepathy. So only when Humanity will be able to understand deeply quantum physics -and it's coming soon,- will it understand telepathy.

If one particle of light is moving like that and you apply some powerful energy and you make this little particle turn left, behind a wall, another particle at same time without receiving the energy will move as well, that looks completely 'magic'.

So if it happens to a particle, what are our brains made of ? Atoms, molecules, particles... so when one is thinking of something, other brains does it too, understanding or not understanding it. It's not a question of intelligence.

I can do a meditation in French and even if nobody understands French, and Koichi doesn't talk, you will feel it, because my brain affects your brain. Languages are not important. Understanding is not important.

Telepathy is outside of understanding, it is connected to Quantum Physics. And that's what soon scientists will be able to explain. If we can move 2 particles at the same time by only moving one, we can also move brains, the inside of brains.

That's why when we are together you feel something good, better than when you are far away. Because when we are together, this powerful energy which is also working from far, is working better.

That's why it's so important to be together every Sunday at 11 am.

Climbing the Fujiyama will not bring you anything.


Maybe you will be tired, but you will see the world from a different place, and then what ?

(slowly), It's exactly the same, but most of the people do their vacuuming (quick) and rush to go to Maitreya garden. No. Vacuuming is a meditation. Enjoy and do it everyday, not once a week, because if you have a zen garden you do it everyday. It is the same with vacuuming. Don't do it as a boring task, do it as something extraordinary. You use the same movement. And think that the zen garden is your little apartment.



In the same way, maybe you don't have many flowers for gardening, but maybe you have a little flower in a pot. Take care of it. And if you wash your food, and prepare your food for your lunch and dinner, do it with love, like a meditation.

What is simple ?

For example a carrot. Did you see the color of a carrot ? So beautiful. It's the same color as the one of a Buddhist monk's dress, orange. Did you ever check the color of a carrot in your life? In Japan you know what is beautiful rice, shining, like ivory.

Going to your bed, look at your bed, make it like a zen garden. Some people don't make their bed, they say tonight I'll sleep, I don't have to clean it. It's another zen garden. It's a very important place, the place where you have your dreams at night, prepare it with love.

Everything, every little details. Even when you go to toilet, it must be a meditation time. First of all, to be able to poo and pee is a very good feeling. It is pleasurable. Many people cannot do it and that is not fun. In every way, even the smell and the noise are nice.

Today, I want you to really say "Thank You Elohim", more than usual, more strongly.

Remember the first time you read the Messages, always remember this first time. What was your feeling then, do you remember ? It must not change for less, it must only change for more.

Never get used to the Elohim, always go back to this first feeling. If we don't do that, we lose our most important treasure.

You must never change this feeling, because this is a new person everyday.

Everyday, each one of us, we change and we are new, more powerful, reaching a higher level of consciousness.

Do it also with yourself looking at the mirror.

One of the most important reasons why people go depressed is because they look at themselves in the mirror and they say "it's me". "I know me, and I am older everyday, with less hair, and more pimples, my breast is going down".

That is not good. Every morning look in the mirror and be surprised!

Do you remember when you were a little baby ? The first time you saw yourself in a mirror, I think you were laughing a lot, making faces. Do the same now! You must be surprised and enthusiastic every morning looking at the new you.

Because we change, we evolve, we become better and better everyday. You learn new things.

So, you look at the mirror and it's somebody new. When you open your bathroom before looking in the mirror be surprised. Say what kind of person will be in the mirror today ? What kind of face ? I know it's a new me. And then you open the door and you go in the mirror and Wow! Be surprised.

Habit is the most depressing thing in life. Don't get used to yourself.

People age and become old, and old in the brain when they see "it's me and I will never change, I am like that forever". This is terrible and depressing. That is why many old people are depressed : "I've always been like that and I will be like that forever". It is so stupid.

If you keep these child eyes, go and see in the mirror a new you everyday.

A happy new you.

Happy new you to you ! (on the melody of happy birthday) Everyday! So if you start with yourself, which is how real love starts, then it's real love! Everyday being surprised of a new you. If you start with you, then you can do it with other people.

If you start your day saying "Ah, it's me, my face, I know my face", then you will look at your boyfriend or girlfriend or neighbor and say the same "I know this person", and you will look at The Message and say "oh, I know this book", and about Elohim "I know Elohim"... and then you go down.

There are no more exciting things in your life.

Even if you have a beautiful boyfriend or girlfriend, "ah I know, the same face, same breast, same sex". And everything looks the same and you get depressed.

Be surprised of yourself, a 'happy new you', and then 'happy new other people' around you.

Be surprised, even if they don't realize it, if they are "yes, same, same", look at them and say : "wow, you are different this morning".

Usually they are surprised because they think they are not different.

They are "oh no". So look at them and say "you are so different this morning".

Say "look at you"! They will ask you "Why? am I older and more ugly".

'No no no, you are more beautiful and something,' and the people like that will get happier. This is how to spread love.

Love is not just looking at another person and say I love you, because Rael says it and asks us to give love to other people.

Love is being surprised of being with other people.

Finding every diamond, what is new and beautiful in other people, and telling them!

Wow! there is new people here. I never saw these faces here. I know you but I never saw these faces.

There is a new Ideaki! So different, he looks happier. Everybody here. There is a new Mariko, very different of last night. I'm so happy and every time better.

And then you look at the Message, it is new Message! Every time you read it, it must be new! You read it and because you have changed you can understand different parts of the Message.

And it goes the same with the Elohim.

You look at Elohim, you think about Elohim, don't think "ah the Elohim, I know everything", No!

I go to Sunday meeting with Rael, "I know Rael, I've been with him for a long time!. Same face, same beard, same medal,"

No! Look at me, what is new in me ? I am completely different of the way I was last time you saw me.

Tomorrow, I will be different, because I want to be different, I want to change.

I want to find new ways. I have new shoes, that you can see, but inside also there are new things, everyday.

And you must do the same, then you are surprised.

Surprised by the Message, read it! Who didn't read the Messages for more than 1 week? 2 weeks ? 1 month? 3 months?

Look at it! I'm still surprised.

The lake ? It is not the same, there is less water, almost no water. So we will dig, to make it a lake, because there is no water now. It changed.

A happy new you, sees happy new others, reads wonderful new Message, and thinks about new Elohim.

Elohim saw you in a special way 10 years ago, or last year. Now they look at you in a different way.

Depending on what you do in your life. If you don't care about the Messages, if you don't read the Messages, if you don't spread love on Earth, they don't look at you in the same way. But if you do what is said in the Messages, they look also at you in a different way. They are proud of you, they love you, and their love for you is different everyday.

That is why looking at yourself as somebody new, other people as people new, every second, is important.

On that day Maitreya was in Japan, in a Zen garden where He loves using his rake in the pebbles.

"It's my daily meditation" he explained.

He then talked about seizing the moment:

"We must seize the moment, each moment, all moments are important.

Here and now, this is happiness. You are attending the Happiness Academy, happiness is here and now.

What does "here and now" mean? Is it only here and only now? Of course not! It is also before and also after. And also here and there (moving). And here as well. And happiness is here and now.

Right now, yes!

What is here? Here is nice, there is nice as well.

So, "Happiness is here and now" could be misinterpreted, like for example "happiness is only here and only now, not later or elsewhere".

No. We should not look for happiness in the future, the past, tomorrow, yesterday, or anywhere else than where we are. However, our current location, even if we are still, is moving because the Earth is rotating.

We are moving with the Earth at tens of thousands of km per day. We are moving at the speed of a jet-powered airplane while being still.

Therefore we can not actually be still. "Here" does not exist, since "here" is moving.

In the infinity of space and time, there is no "here" since "here" is moving. The Earth moves around the solar system, which adds to our speed, and our galaxy is moving as well...

So, there is no "here", we can't be still. It's impossible to be still.

And it's beautiful, it means that "here" is in the movement – the Raelian movement of course - "here" is in the movement and now.

The same is true with "now". By the time we pronounce the word it is already gone, it's no longer "now". "Now" moves, therefore we have "here" moving and "now" moving as well. So, everything is moving!

ELOHIKA, MAITREYA ADDRESSES THE PARTICIPANTS OF THE KAMA SEMINARS IN BURKINA FASO IN AUGUST

I am going to put a little more emphasis on your keeping your color since you have greeted me with Kama drums, and Kama screams that I love: that wonderful Kama ooooooooooh.

It is important that you, Kamaians, keep your personal color. It is fine to try to look like Europeans, in science, and to pass them, in wisdom, and pass them, but you must keep your joy of life, your enthusiasm...

Lamane who is level 5, of remarkable intelligence and brilliant, dances and I love to see Lamane dance! Tai, who is a man of great wisdom too, plays and laughs with me all the time; Zadou the great, we always laugh when we are together!

It is true that the science, the knowledge, and the spiritual wisdom of Europeans and Asians must be assimilated while not resembling them in their seriousness. It is important to keep playing the drums, to dance, to sing, to act silly because if the Europeans are somewhat ahead scientifically, they are far behind in matters of pleasure, in fulfillment that the Elohim also teach us.

You can all become Buddhas. There are many Buddhas! Every individual that blossoms and reaches a higher level of consciousness than the others, becomes Buddha. So, in Buddhist temples, you have statues of hundreds of Buddhas. There are hundreds, thousands, there are new ones everyday. And you are buddhas; to be a buddha is to be someone who has raised his level of consciousness, who is happy, who feels good in his being, in his consciousness.

That is what you need to do. So, above everything, don't make the mistake of losing this joy of life. That is why our

seminars have become the happiness academy, the university of happiness, the awaking seminar puts so much emphasis on happiness. Because you cannot raise your level of consciousness if you lose happiness.

EUROPEAN Raelian Movement SUES POPE BENEDICT XVI

LONDON, Sept. 13 – The European Raelian Movement (ERM) has filed a lawsuit in the High Court, Queen’s Bench Division, against Pope Benedict XVI, formerly Cardinal Ratzinger. Allegations in the suit include charges of violating international human rights laws, perpetrating genocide by continuing to claim that condoms don’t stop the spread of AIDS, and stating that Pope Benedict and the Vatican orchestrated a campaign of disinformation against the business of the ERM after its membership reported on these matters.

The ERM says it can prove its allegations.

“The Vatican has maintained an ongoing campaign against the ERM for years,” said Marcus Wenner, Raelian bishop of the U.K. Raelian Movement. “That campaign was obviously carried out in retaliation for the Movement’s clear stance against pedophilia and the cover-ups rampant within the Catholic Church clergy. And there are several other tenets of Vatican policy the Raelian Movement directly opposes, such as its genocidal position against using condoms in Africa, which results in continued HIV infections, deaths of millions and subsequent orphaning of children.

Forewarning Benedict XVI of the impending suit, the ERM also claimed in its pre-litigation letter that his actions continue to violate international law along with treaties on genocide and those concerning organized sexual abuse and trafficking in children.

“We are indeed aware of the seriousness of the allegations and we will provide documents which we feel are ample proof,” Wenner said. Vatican actions or lack of actions have violated many international laws, such as The Convention on the Rights of the Child, The Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union (Articles X & XXII) and the Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms (Article IX).”

Under Pope John Paul II, then-Cardinal Ratzinger was in charge of dealing with the pedophilia scandal, to which Raelians were drawing attention in the 1990’s.

While Richard Dawkins and others have voiced their desire to have Pope Benedict arrested for such crimes as the ERM is alleging, U.K. Raelians are contending in court that they have a greater right to sue because of the history of legal judgments against them. In one such case a few years ago, a Belgian court ruled against NOPEDO, a branch of the ERM, for publicizing the Vatican’s pedophilia cover-ups. In a report released in Belgium last week by church investigator Peter Adriaenssens, more than 300 cases of abuse are listed, mostly involving minors. The report said they had been found in nearly every diocese, and 13 alleged victims had committed suicide.

The ERM maintains that the Vatican’s onslaught has caused damage to its reputation.






YOAV SHAMIR NEW HONORARY GUIDE OF THE RAE LIAN MOVEMENT

Lola (a famous topless protester from Austin) showed up with about 4 girls and 4 guys. There were men with bikini tops, one guy in a towel around his body and another towel wrapped on his head as if he just got out of the shower and he held the towel up over his chest the whole time. We had men in top and bottom bikinis, we had a beautiful young woman with her husband and baby in a carriage. The husband wore a bikini top and the young woman/mother would stop for the camera periodically and breast feed the kid! It was fantastic.

Anyway, when we pulled up to the intersection of 6th street and Congress Ave, there were cameras (plural) on all 4 corners. We were about 10 minutes late and they were waiting and already set up. We did the great "late entrance". We found a perfect place to park and got organized in a flash and started walking. There were people everywhere. We estimate there were 50-60 people actively participating. We all walked down the wide sidewalk north up 6th street about 8 blocks and turned around and walked south the same amount.

Today was another fantastic day! The weather was with us a hot and sunny 32C. The Toronto Team who participated in the event drove altogether in Patrick's van. We were six (Patrick, Ben, Louise, Catherine, Gisele and I), and I have to say the impact we had when we arrived was huge. It was 3:00 PM when we arrived. Right upon arrival, I removed my top before leaving the van and walked on the street to St. Georges Square where the event was. There was a small group of people. Then while we were waiting for the traffic light, Catherine, Gisele and Louise decided to remove their top on the street corner. As we crossed the streets, we started getting a lot of attention. We walked into St. Georges Square and I looked for Andrea but couldn't see her. But when she saw me, she jumped on me, right in the middle of the place and she gave me the biggest hug ever. She was shaking like a leaf and kept saying: "I AM SO HAPPY YOU ARE HERE! THANK YOU, THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR COMING!" She said: "Lindsay and I were so worried, we were going to be the only women topfree in this place." Then as we were speaking we heard the entire crowd starting to applaud us, it was very moving. There were so many men and women gathering all around St. George's Square and as I saw the crowd growing very rapidly, I started distributing our flyers right away.



Very quickly after we gathered, a big crowd surrounded St. George's Square. At 3:30 PM Andrea and Lindsay kicked off the event by welcoming everyone. At some point, there must have been 350 people in the place but people were coming and going and all were wondering what was going to happen. Andrea and Lindsay had organized a line-up of artists all very mellow type of music, it was very zen and there was a beautiful atmosphere. Everyone was peaceful and very respectful. Many men congratulating us for doing this. Two body painters started painting people who wanted to participate (men and women and charged them \$5.00 to cover the cost of their paint). The body painters did very beautiful design and very progressively we saw the number of topless women growing.

I was scheduled to do my speech at 4:15 PM, Lindsay introduced me as Diane Brisebois from GoTopless. Andrea and Lindsay sat nearby while I spoke. There was a very good PA system with a microphone and my voice carried well in the Square and over the downtown streets. I had decided to put back my top for the beginning of my speech and during my speech when I spoke our body being a Masterpiece and that women needed to shed their fear and shame to exercise their rights, I asked them to do it with me and I took off my top and so did a few more women and men. I also recognized Andrea and Lindsay, organiser of this event, two extraordinary courageous women paving the way inspiring and empowering other women to do the same. I was very proud of them.

Many media were present, a University radio station for which I gave an interview, a Waterloo newspaper, a Guelph news-

paper and another freelancer. A journalist named Louise, who was present and supported Gwen Jacobs 20 years ago when Gwen fought and celebrated her victory, also interviewed me and told me that she was the one behind Gwen Jacobs breastfeeding her baby at the time.

One thing touched me very much out of this whole experience today. After my speech, there were numerous people who came to talk to me, women and men congratulating me on a very inspiring presentation and one men said to me: "Thank you for doing this, I removed my top when you did during your speech and you have no idea how liberating this was for me!!!" There are men just like women who don't dare taking off their top in public... whether because they have a scar or they don't feel they have the beautiful abs that women love to look at or other personal reasons that they won't say but... men just like women also have hundreds of reasons not to remove their top because they are not comfortable with their imperfections. This event was just as liberating for them as it was for women! There were a number of older ladies who joined and had their breasts painted and were so happy. It was very interesting to watch and see people taking their courage and removing their top. Even one of the men who interviewed me had a scar under his belly button and he said to me: "Since I have this scar, I haven't been able to remove my shirt in public and I have to say that it feels really good to do this today, so I perfectly understand how women must feel to do this. Another men who had heart surgery, had a big scar on his chest and ever since felt very uncomfortable removing his shirt, so he had his scar painted and he ask to have "Equal rights for all or for none" painted on his chest. It was very moving to hear these testimonies, everyone had a story to share and how liberating it was for everyone.

Hundreds of photos were taken and at some point we took a group picture with all those who accepted to be in this photo. We distributed between 500 and 600 flyers promoting our next year event on Sunday August 28, 2010 on Toronto beaches.




TWO WEEK SEMINAR WITH PEOPLE I LOVE
